September 2021

Nationwide, existing home sales were down slightly in August, falling 2% after two consecutive months of increases, according to the National Association of REALTORS®. The decline in existing home sales coincides with rising sales prices, which have continued to soar into fall, with the median sales price of existing homes up 14.9% compared to last year. Declining affordability has had a significant impact on homebuyers, many of whom have been priced out of the market and are choosing to wait for sales prices to ease before resuming their home search.

New Listings were down 10.1 percent for single-family homes and 5.1 percent for condominium properties. Closed Sales decreased 11.3 percent for single-family homes but increased 2.4 percent for condominium properties.

The Median Sales Price was up 7.1 percent to \$525,000 for single-family homes and 9.5 percent to \$460,000 for condominium properties. Months Supply of Inventory decreased 33.3 percent for single-family units and 50.0 percent for condominium units.

There are signs the market may be shifting, however. New listings have continued to hit the market, bucking seasonality trends commonly seen in the fall, a time when listing and sales activity typically slows as children return to school. As inventory increases, competition for homes may soften, and could even bring a moderation in sales prices, which, after 114 months of year-overyear gains, would be music to the ears of homebuyers throughout the country.

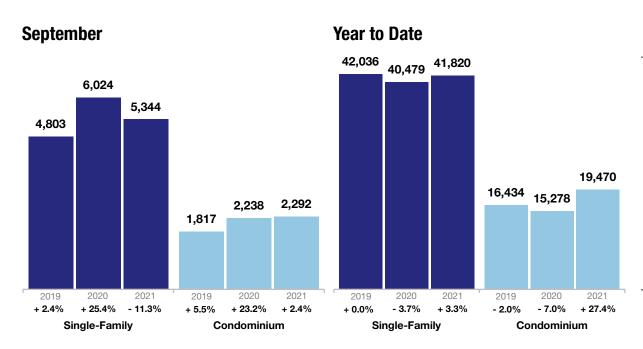

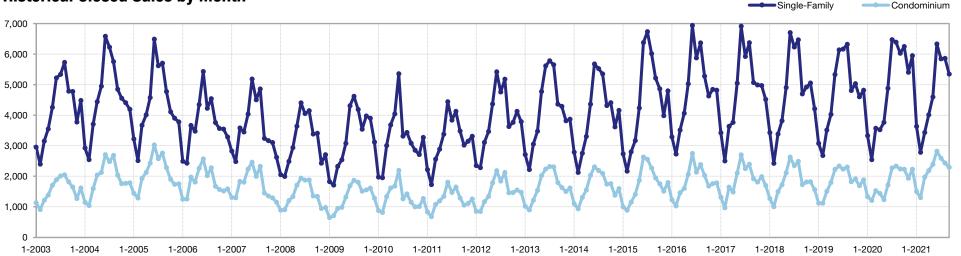

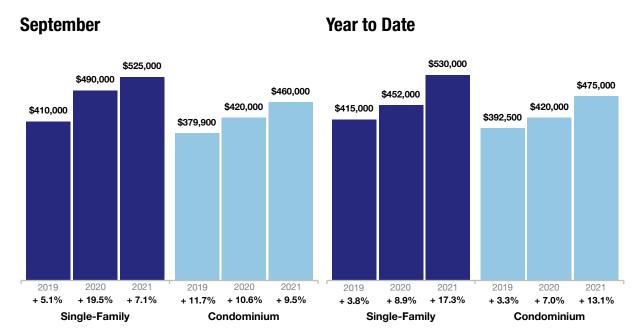
Historical Closed Sales by Month

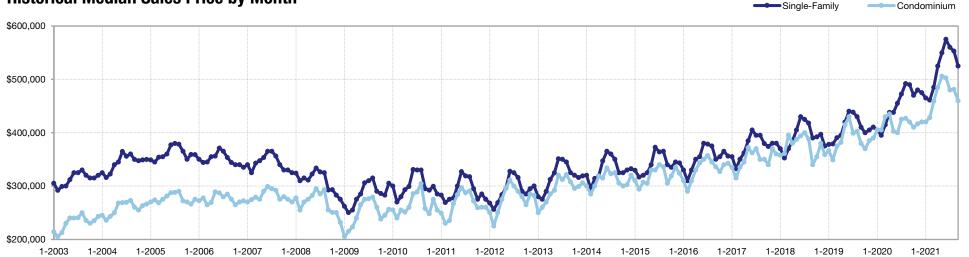

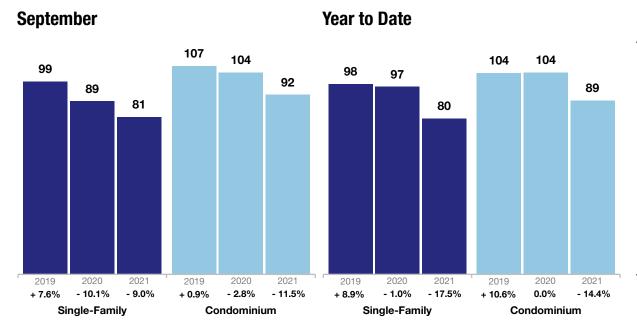
Historical Median Sales Price by Month

This index measures housing affordability for the region. For example, an index of 120 means the median household income is 120% of what is necessary to qualify for the median-priced home under prevailing interest rates. A higher number means greater affordability.

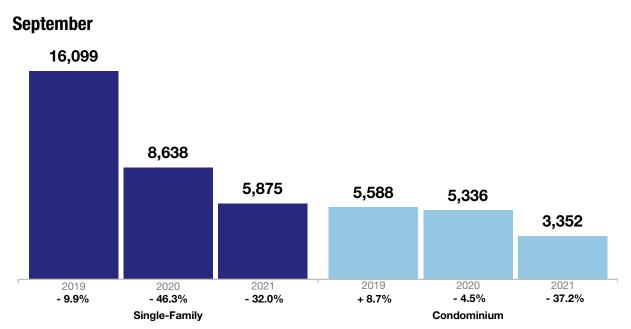
Historical Housing Affordability Index by Month

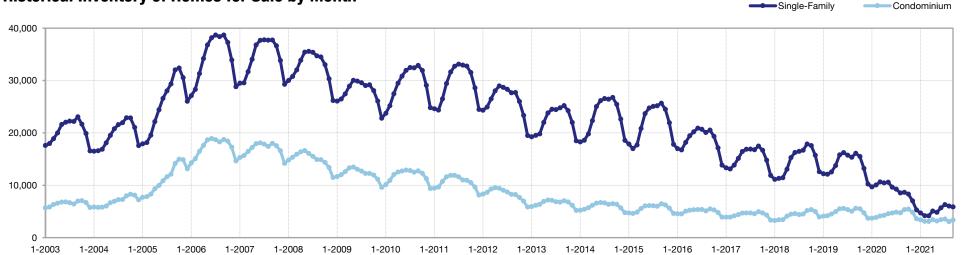

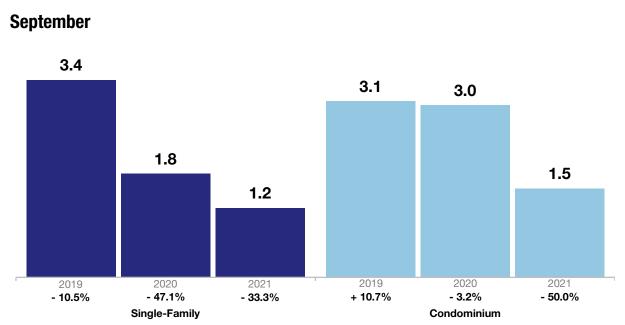
Historical Inventory of Homes for Sale by Month

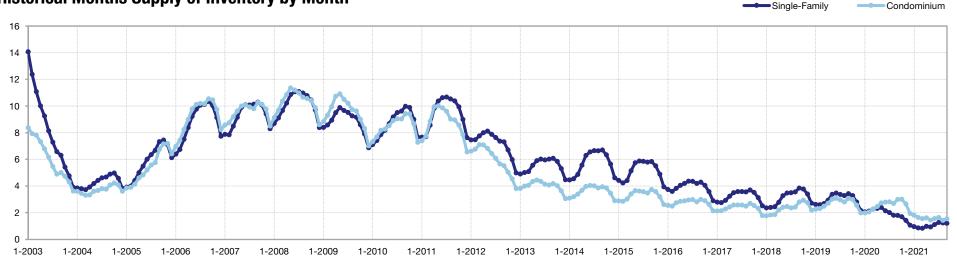

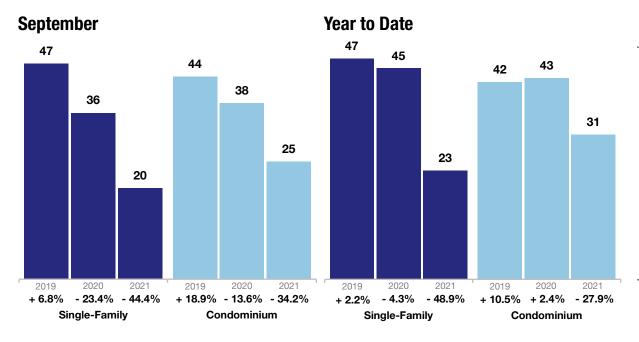
Historical Months Supply of Inventory by Month

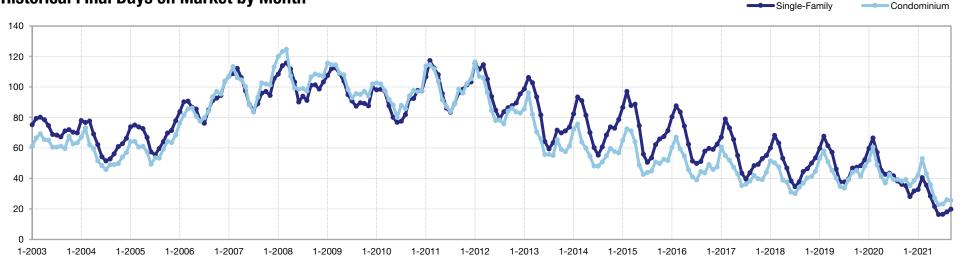

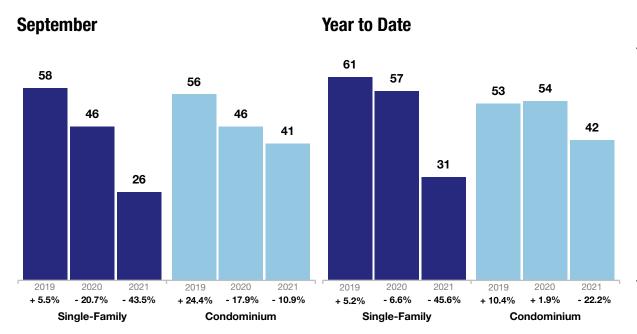
Historical Final Days on Market by Month



Cumulative Days on Market

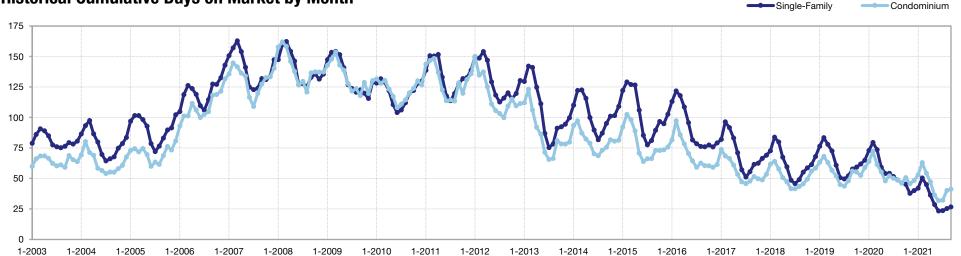

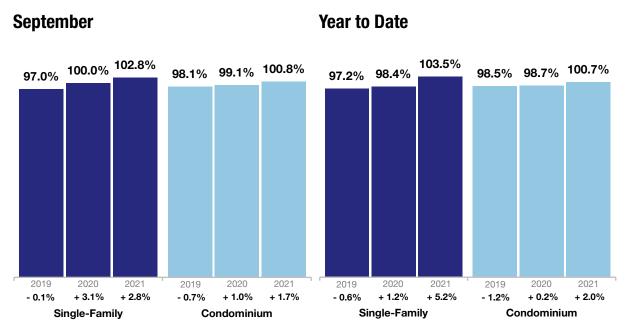
Historical Cumulative Days on Market by Month



Percent of Original List Price Received

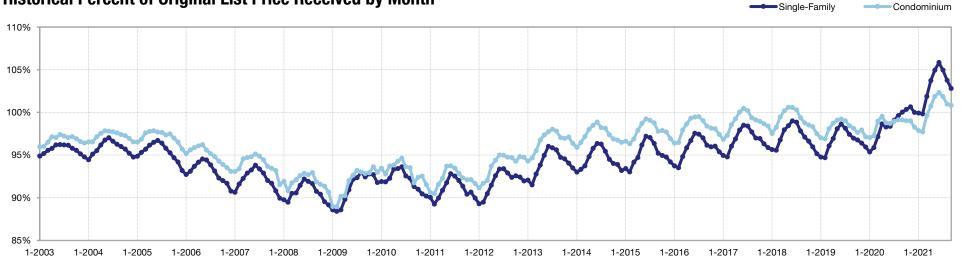

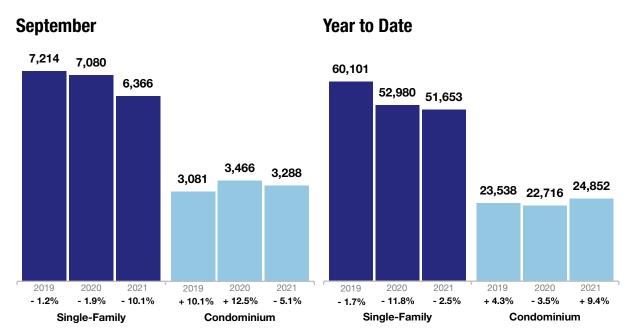
Historical Percent of Original List Price Received by Month

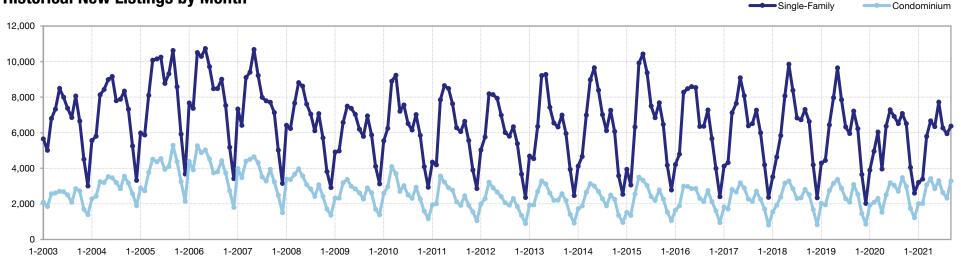

Glossary of Terms

Median Sales Price A measure of home values in a market area where 50% of activity was higher and 50% was lower than this price point. A measure of how affordable a region's housing is to its consumers. A higher number means greater affordability. The index is based on interest rates, median sales price and average income by county. Inventory of Homes for Sale A measure of the number of homes available for sale at a given time. Once a listing goes pending, sold or is taken off the market, it is no longer considered "active." The availability of homes for sale has a big effect on supply-demand dynamics and home prices.
Inventory of Homes for Sale A measure of the number of homes available for sale at a given time. Once a listing goes pending, sold or is taken off the market, it is no longer considered "active." The availability of homes for sale has a big effect on supply-demand dynamics and home prices.

Months Comply of Inventory of homes for calc (at the end of a given month) divided by the average monthly panding calca from the last 10 months
Months Supply of Inventory The inventory of homes for sale (at the end of a given month) divided by the average monthly pending sales from the last 12 months.
A measure of how many calendar days pass between when a listing becomes active (not pending) for the last time to the last time it goes pending directly before it is sold. A pending sale is defined as something classified as Pending, Active with a Flag, Contingent or Under Agreement.
Cumulative Days on Market Until Sale A measure of the average number of calendar days that pass from when a listing is first listed to when a property goes into the last pend status before it is sold.
Percent of Original List Price Received This is calculated as Total Sold Dollars (all sold prices added together) divided by Total Original Price (all original list prices added together)
New Listings A measure of how much new supply is coming onto the market from sellers. It is calculated by counting all listings with a list date in the reporting period.
