The Massachusetts Association of REALTORS® (MAR), a 99-year-old professional trade association with over 25,000 members, opposes rent control in all forms.

- Massachusetts has a housing crisis caused by:
 - Significant shortfall in supply due to stagnant housing production. This also results in old, and thus expensive to maintain, housing stock.
- Wages falling behind consumer goods prices, especially at lower-income levels.
- Rent control worsens the housing crisis by further disincentivizing production and maintenance of multifamily housing.
- The state's housing crisis exists largely from decades of municipal NIMBYism, which put up roadblocks to multifamily housing production.
- Solutions:
 - Stop discrimination against multifamily housing production.
 - Increase funding for voucher programs to help those in need.
